### **ELIGIBILITY CLAUSES AND ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS - PGET-2024**

Admission to PG Medical and PG Dental seats shall be made in accordance with the "Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for selection and admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma courses Rules, 2006 (Amendments) as amended from time to time", therefore the details and instructions contained in this Information Bulletin are subject to the said Rules and Government orders, in case of any discrepancy, the Rules shall prevail; and subject to

the guidelines / instructions of NMC / MCC / DCI / Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GOI / Government of India / Government of Karnataka / Director Medical Education, Karnataka / PG Entrance Test Committee and orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India issued from time to time on the conduct of Centralized Counseling for the seats to be notified by the Karnataka State Government, in Government, KPCF, KRLMPCA, AMPCK and private university institutions.

The details and instructions contained in this Information Booklet are subject to the said Rules and Government orders. In case of any discrepancy, the Rules shall prevail and the decision of Government / Entrance Test Committee shall be final.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY

# **4.1 ELIGIBILITY for Government seats (G) seats:**

- (a) A candidate must be a citizen of India; and
- (b) have studied and passed MBBS/BDS in a recognized Medical /Dental institution in the state of Karnataka; or
- (c) have studied and passed MBBS/BDS in recognized Medical / Dental institutions located in India and has studied for a minimum period of ten academic years commencing from 1st standard to 12<sup>th</sup> standard and must have appeared and passed either SSLC or 10<sup>th</sup> standard or 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC or 12<sup>th</sup> standard equivalent examination from the Karnataka State are eligible."

In case of the candidate who has taken more than one year to pass a class or standard, the years of academic study is counted as one year only.

**Note:** Children for the purpose of the rule means Natural born son / daughter and not adopted son/daughter and not grandson / granddaughter.

For the purpose of document verification and eligibility the following clauses shall be used.

Provided that the explanation mentioned above shall not be applicable in following cases:

Son or daughter of serving employee, belonging to All India Service of Karnataka cadre, who has served or is serving outside the State of Karnataka during the period corresponding to candidate's study outside the State from 1<sup>st</sup> standard to 12<sup>th</sup> Standard examination can be added to make up the ten years of study within Karnataka as required under clause

Son or daughter of an employee of the Union Government or employee of Union or Karnataka State Government undertaking or Joint Sector undertaking where such employee:

- had declared to the employer at the time of joining service any place in Karnataka to be his home town; and
- 2. had studied in any Government or Government recognized educational institution or institutions located in Karnataka for a minimum period of 10 years; and was or is liable to be transferred anywhere in India as per the terms and conditions of his employment. Further, the candidate must have passed the Qualifying Examination from a University or Board or any other institution located anywhere in India.

### 4.2 ELIGIBILITY for Private seats

(GMP, OPN & MK, MA, ME, MU, MC, MM seats):

### A. GMP

A candidate who fulfills the eligibility as per criteria clause b/c.

### B. OPN

A candidate who is citizen of India; and have studied and passed MBBS / BDS in a recognized Medical / Dental institution.

# **C.** For Religious Minority:

- i. Christian Minority of Karnataka\* & Non-Karnataka.
- ii. Muslim Minority of Karnataka\* & Non- Karnataka.
- \*Christian and Muslim minority candidates of clause b/c are considered as Karnataka Religious minority candidate.
- \*\* Karnataka Religious minority candidates will be considered first; then, non-Karnataka religious minority candidates if any will be considered later.

# D. Linguistic Minority (MA, ME, MK, MU):

- i) Linguistic Minority Reservation is applicable to persons belonging to linguistic minority of the Karnataka state whose mother tongue is Tamil or Telugu or Kodava or Tulu; and
- ii) A candidate who has studied and passed in one or more Government or Government recognized, educational institutions located in the State of Karnataka for a minimum period of TEN academic years commencing from 1st standard to 12th and must have appeared and passed either SSLC/10th standard or 2nd PUC/12th standard examination from Karnataka State.

## 4.3 ELIGIBILITY for NRI seats(N):

i. Has obtained MBBS or BDS degree in a Medical or Dental in recognized institutions which should be approved by MCI / DCI.

- ii. All NRI / NRI Wards / PIO / OCI candidates and Foreign Nationals.
- Children of Non-resident Indian or their Wards. (As per Hon'ble High Court in WP Nos.17999-18002/2017)
- iv. Relationship of NRI with the candidate as per the court orders of The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(c) No. 689/2017- Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. dated 22-08-2017.
- v. As per the definition defined in The Karnataka Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) Act, 2006 read with the Karnataka Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) (Amendment) Act, 2017 and the Income Tax Act 1961 Section 115 C (e) & 6, i.e., " Non Resident Indian" means an individual resident outside India who is a citizen of India or is a Person of Indian Origin and includes Persons of Indian Origin and Overseas Citizens of India.

# 4.4 ELIGIBILITY for Other seats (Q):

Has studied MBBS or BDS degree in a Medical or Dental colleges affiliated to any University established by law in India recognized by Medical Council of India or Dental Council of India and Government of India. All the candidates who have qualified in NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 are eligible except NRI / PIO / OCI and Foreign Nationals.

### 5. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED

The Karnataka Examinations Authority or the Entrance Test Committee may from time to time specify for submission such other additional documents and issue directions as deemed essential for all candidates for maintaining absolute transparency and integrity in the document verification process, determination of eligibility and seat allotment and admission - through a notification on the website of KEA / updates on MCI / MCC.

### **5.1 MANDATORY documents**

- 1. KEA 'PGET-2024' Registration form duly filled (print out).
- Photo identity and address proof document (PAN Card / Driving License / Voter ID / Passport / Aadhaar Card / Ration Card)

- 4. SSLC or 10th Standard / equivalent marks card (For date of birth).

- 8. Provisional Degree Certificate only to those who have passed MBBS / BDS during 2024.
- Certificate of internship completion in Annexure 5 for candidates who have already completed internship. (Provisional internship completion certificate will be accepted for Candidates completing their internship 30-06-2024 for MDS and 15-08-2024 for MD/MS, only for 1st round of counseling in Annexure 6).
- 10. Certificate from the head of institute certifying that the Medical / Dental College from which the candidate has passed MBBS/BDS examination is recognized by MCI/DCI.
- 11. State / Central Medical / Dental Council Registration Certificate. [Provisional registration certificate will be accepted only for the candidates who have passed MBBS / BDS during 2024. Permanent State / Central Medical / Dental Council Registration Certificate to be compulsorily submitted at the time of admission process. (Candidates who have passed prior to 2024, should compulsory possess the Original Permanent Registration certificate and upload the same)]
- 12. Eligibility Certificate (Other University)
- 13. All the candidates are also required to produce UNDERTAKING (Annexure 7), taken on a white paper. Further the same undertaking obtained on Rs. 20 e-Stamps Paper brought out in the name of the candidate to the Karnataka Examinations Authority as shown in (Annexure 7), only on submission of this document, candidate's admission process is stated to be completed and he /she becomes eligible for admission /allotment of User ID and Secret Key.

371(j) (Hyderabad-Karnataka Region) certificate - If applicable, Certificates issued by the competent authority for claiming reservation under 371(j) (Hyderabad-Karnataka Region). (Annexure-8) should be uploaded.

**NOTE:** Indian citizens or Overseas Citizens of India who have obtained their Primary Medical Qualifications from Medical Colleges outside India should have qualified in the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (Screening Test) which is conducted by National Board of Examinations - Document mandatorily to be uploaded. Further, they should have been registered with MCI / SMC and should have completed their internship or likely to complete their internship on or before 30-06-2024 for MDS and 15-08-2024 for MD/MS. **(Annexure 18)** 

# Other mandatory certificates:

- 14. Eligibility Certificate by RGUHS for the candidates graduated from other university other than RGUHS (To be submitted at the respective admitted college).
- 15. Migration certificate from the concerned University if MBBS / BDS done from other than RGUHS, Bangalore. (To be submitted at the respective admitted college).
- 16. Compulsory rural service bond on Rs.100/- stamp paper (Annexure 1) and undertaking for three years service on Rs 200/- stamp paper duly notarized (Annexure 2). (to be submitted at the time of admission process)

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Mere qualifying in NEET-PG 2024 / NEET PG MDS-2024 does not confer any right on the candidate for admission unless the candidate fulfils eligibility conditions / submits the documents / certificates. Further, only the candidates who complete the registration process including document verification are eligible for PG Medical seats in Government / Private Colleges in Karnataka.
- 2. Candidates have to appear for verification of documents as per the schedule according to PG NEET MDS 2024 All India Dental rank in the Centre.
- Candidates will be allowed to enter the premises in the order of All India Rank and only 15 minutes before the scheduled time; hence candidates are advised to appear as per the scheduled time.
- 4. Candidates should compulsorily produce all the required documents in ORIGINAL with two sets photocopies of all the original documents.
- 5. The candidates who become eligible after verification will only be considered for entry of options to become eligible for allotment of seats.
- 6. Candidates have to be personally present as per the schedule for verifying the documents and no one can represent them.
- 7. KEA will publish the details of eligible candidates on the website <a href="http://kea.kar.nic.in">http://kea.kar.nic.in</a> after verification.
- 8. Candidates can bring drinking water bottle with them, candidates may carry some food and medicines if required.
- 9. The candidate should bring all necessary original documents with them in support of their claim / reservation made in their online application.
- 10. Verification of original documents requires more time for scrutiny of each certificate produced by the candidate. Hence the process may get delayed. Candidates have to appear in the order of All India Rank / schedule. Request to verify documents before the schedule time will not be entertained. Candidates have to arrange their return journey accordingly.
