The Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA), Bengaluru is designated by Government of Karnataka to conduct online counseling for admission to Post Graduate Degree / Diploma Courses in Government Medical and Dental colleges, Government Quota seats in Private and Minority Medical and Dental Colleges and Private seats in Private Medical and Dental colleges (KPCF, KRLMPCA, AMPCK & Private Universities) located in the State of Karnataka for the academic year 2024-25.

Admission to PG Medical and PG Dental seats shall be made in accordance with the "Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for selection and admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma courses Rules, 2006 (Amendments) as amended from time to time", therefore the details and instructions contained in this Information Bulletin are subject to the said Rules and Government orders, in case of any discrepancy, the Rules shall prevail; and subject to the guidelines / instructions of NMC / MCC / DCI / Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GOI / Government of India / Government of Karnataka / Director Medical Education, Karnataka / PG Entrance Test Committee and orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India issued from time to time on the conduct of Centralized Counseling for the seats to be notified by the Karnataka State Government, in Government, KPCF, KRLMPCA, AMPCK and private university institutions.

The details and instructions contained in this Information Booklet are subject to the said Rules and Government orders. In case of any discrepancy, the Rules shall prevail and the decision of Government / Entrance Test Committee shall be final.

PWD Reservations:

Eligibility for Benchmark Disabilities is as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016.

PWD reservation is applicable to Karnataka candidates only. All the candidates need to appear for medical examination at KEA, premises compulsorily on the dates notified.

NOTE: Before applying under PWD, ensure that you are eligible as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016. Candidates will be disqualified at any stage of admission, if they found not-eligible as per Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016.

NOTE: As per NMC, New Delhi letter dated 24-07-2023; all the rounds of counseling including Stray Vacancy Round will be conducted only by KEA in online mode, all the candidates who have qualified in NEET PG 2024 are hereby advised to register online and complete the document verification process in KEA to become eligible for admission to PG Medical and Dental Courses in the State of Karnataka.

FLOW CHART

Online registration, payment of registration fee, entry of application details online.

Verification of Original Documents at KEA, Bangalore as per schedule.

After Verification, collect the original documents and verification slip from the Verification Officer. Before leaving the verification counter verify the details printed on the verification slip.

Do not share the Secret Key printed on the verification slip with anyone. Read Information Bulletin for entry of options and seat allotment procedure.

Entry of options by the eligible candidates

Option entry means, indication of colleges / courses in the order of priority in to the KEA portal.

Publication of Mock Seat Allotment result

Based on the priority of options entered by the candidates and merit, seat allotment will take place.

After the mock seat allotment results are published, candidates can add or delete or modify or rearrange the options. Finally saved options will be used for seat allotment.

Publication of First round Seat Allotment result

Seat Allotted in First Round– Select the appropriate Choice

Satisfied with the allotted seat, will pay the fees, submit the originals, collect the admission order and report to college. Not eligible for second round or any other rounds of 2023.

Not satisfied, but wish to participate in 2nd round without holding any seat. Submit the originals. Wait for 2nd round.

During Second round, candidates can alter or delete or modify or rearrange the options. Finally saved options will be used for seat allotment

Clinical Seat Allotted

Publication of Second Round seat allotment result

Compulsorily join the allotted college. Not eligible for mop-up round.

EXIT

Pre / Para Clinical Seat Allotted, wait for the mop-up round, only for clinical seat. If interested.

Seat not allotted, wait for the mop-up round.

Mop-up round

STAY/Leaveover round- only for not allotted any seats. Subject to availability of seats.

IMPORTANT NOTE

1. All the candidates who have qualified in PGNEET-MDS 2024 / PGNEET-2024 are hereby advised to register and complete the document verification process to become eligible for admission to PG Medical and PG Dental Courses in the State of Karnataka.
2. All the rounds of counseling including Stray Vacancy Round will be conducted in online mode as per NMC, New Delhi letter dated 24-07-2023. (Annexure-21)
3. Please ensure that you have read and understood thoroughly the process of Centralized Counseling and the procedure to be followed.
4. In case you are still facing issues, then make use of the candidate helpline either by phone or email.
5. Phone support will be available during 10:00AM to 6:00 PM from Monday to Saturday. Candidate Helpline will be closed on nonworking Sundays & General holidays.

All candidates are directed to visit the website of KEA <http://kea.kar.nic.in> at least twice every day for updates. KEA or the Directorate of Medical Education or the Government shall not be responsible for any action / consequence/s resulting due to non-diligent follow up of notices, notifications and publications appearing on the KEA website on NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 by the candidates.

Mere qualifying in NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 does not confer any right on the candidate unless the candidate fulfils eligibility conditions / submission of certificates. Further, only the candidates who complete the registration process including document verification (holding verification slip) are eligible for admission to PG Medical / Dental seats in Government / Private Colleges in Karnataka.

CAUTION: No new registration will be allowed after the first round of seat allotment.

Legal Jurisdiction

Any dispute that may arise in respect of the test or the later seat selection process, admission, fees and cancellation is subject to the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble High court of Karnataka. The issuance of admission order by the KEA shall enable the candidate to join the concerned college, subject to the academic eligibility, etc., being approved by the concerned University as per the Regulations.

APPEAL

Any person aggrieved by the order or decision of the Executive Director under CET-2006 Rules may within 15 days from the date of such order or decision, appeal to the Principal Secretary, Secretary to Government (Higher Education) Department, Government of Karnataka, who after calling for records from the Executive Director and after examining the same, shall pass orders as he deems fit, which shall be final.

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Note on First Round, Second Round, Mop-up Round and Stray Vacancy Round Schedule

All the rounds of online seat allotment would be conducted as per the directions of Central Government / NMC / MCC / State Government / Apex bodies. The schedule for each round will be hosted on the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> along with procedures.

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i) IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Registration of application form for appearing in the NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 is to be undertaken **online only** at <http://kea.kar.nic.in/pget2024.htm> Application forms **CANNOT** be submitted in offline / printed copy by post.

- 1.1 No request for change of details in online application shall be entertained.
- 1.2 The prescribed registration fee of Rs. 750/- (for SC/ST/Cat-1/PWD candidates), Rs. 1500/- (for General/2A/2B/3A/3B candidates) Rs.4000/- for non-Karnataka, and Rs. 7000/- (for NRI/OCI/ PIO/ Foreign Nationals candidates) should be remitted through payment gateway.
- 1.3 The cutoff date for completion of internship towards determination of eligibility in NEET-PG 2024 is **15-08-2024** and NEET MDS 2024 shall be **30-06-2024**(NBE Information Bulletin)
- 1.4 Mere qualifying in NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 does not confer any right on the candidate unless the candidate fulfills eligibility conditions / submission of certificates. Further, only the candidates who complete the registration process and complete the document verification including obtaining of the documents verification slip are eligible for PG Medical / Dental seats in Government / Private Colleges in Karnataka.

Online information provided by candidates like name of candidate, contact address details, category, PWD status, educational qualification details, date of birth etc during online submission of application form for NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 will be treated as correct and KEA will not entertain, under any circumstances, any request for change. KEA disclaims any liability that may arise to candidate(s) due to incorrect information provided by the candidate during online registration process.

- e. KEA does not edit / modify / alter any information entered by the candidates at the time of online submission of application form under any circumstances. In the event of any clarification regarding the eligibility, the provisions of Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for Admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma courses, Rules 2006 as amended from time to time shall prevail and the decision of NMC / MCC / DCI / Government / Competent Authority / Universities / Karnataka Examinations Authority / Entrance test committee shall be final.
- f. Candidature is purely provisional and subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as mentioned in the NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 Information Bulletin. Further, the provisional admission made is subject to approval of MCI / DCI / Government / Competent Authority / Universities / Apex Bodies etc. Mere registering or verifying the documents or receiving the provisionally verified slip does not confer any right to the candidates for admission to Karnataka PG MD / MS / Diploma courses.
- g. The information furnished by the candidate in the PGET-2024 online application form with regard to Caste / Category and Annual Income and other reservations remains the same for the purpose of verification or for allotment of a seat and no change will be entertained in future for any reason.
- h. The candidates deemed to have read and understand the eligibility conditions or procedures as mentioned in the PGNEET Information Bulletin issued by the Central / State counseling conducting authorities.
- i. The instructions and guidelines issued by the Competent Authority from time to time shall be followed.
- j. Non-Karnataka candidates will not be eligible for reservation. Hence, in the NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS - 2024 examination, if they have scored the required minimum 50th percentile or above, fixed for 'GENERAL (UR)' category as per the qualifying criteria, then only they are eligible to register for admissions through KEA or for any other seats in the State of Karnataka. Please note that SC/ST/OBC eligibility criteria are applicable to Karnataka SC/ST/OBC candidates only.

Beware of touts, brokers or middlemen

Few persons may approach you saying they have known people in KEA who guarantee PG seats through unfair means during counseling. Counseling for all PG seats are conducted and distributed as per the calendar of events in the ambit of the State Government rules as per NEET merit score and option entry exercised by the candidate. Hence, candidates and parents should not trust any persons. In case you have any information regarding such persons please intimate to KEA by email immediately.

1. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This Information Bulletin is for NEET PG 2024/ NEET MDS 2024 for admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Courses for the academic session 2024-25 for all seats in the State of Karnataka as notified by Government of Karnataka.

This bulletin is in continuation of information bulletin published by the National Board of Examination. *Information in this bulletin with regard to PG Medical will come in to effect only after announcement from MCC*

Candidates are hereby informed to go through the Information Bulletin carefully and understand / acquaint themselves: -

1. Candidates shall apply "**Online**" only for Karnataka State NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024.
2. Information Bulletin can be downloaded from <http://kea.kar.nic.in/pget2024.htm>
3. Online submission of Application Form shall be made on <http://kea.kar.nic.in/pget2024.htm>
4. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Information Bulletin and notifications published on KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in/pget2024.htm>. Candidates not complying with the instructions will be summarily disqualified.
5. Candidates must retain the following documents with them as reference for future correspondence.
 - (i) At least two printouts of the finally submitted online Application.
 - (ii) Fees paid Receipt
 - (iii) 2 Passport size identical photographs which is uploaded in the Online Application.

6. Registered Mobile Number

- (i) The candidate must ensure that the mobile numbers, e-mail address entered in the NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 online application form are his / her own as in case of urgency KEA may send information / communications by SMS or email on registered mobile number and registered email ID only.
- (ii) An OTP will be sent to the candidate registered mobile number during registration.
- (iii) KEA will not be held responsible for non-receipt of latest information due to wrong mobile number or mailing address filled in the Online Application Form.

7. Candidates must preserve the NBE **Admit Card** till the admission in College or Institution.
8. For the latest updates, candidates must remain in touch with the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in/pget2024.htm> till the completion of all rounds of counseling.
9. Candidates / parents are advised to visit KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> at least twice in a day for the latest news / updates and also check their mobile / e-mail as in case of urgency KEA may send the information / communications.
10. KEA will reserve the right to withdraw any such admission made at any point of time which is not fulfilling the eligibility criteria / regulations fixed by the Competent Authority from time to time.

The Karnataka Examinations Authority, the Directorate of Medical Education, the Government and the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences reserve the right to cause any verification as deemed essential at any point of time into the originality and authenticity of any of the certificates produced by any candidate to fulfill and stake his/her claim to any of the qualifying and eligibility criteria.

If on such verification it is found that the candidate has produced fake, fraudulent certificates, he/she will be liable for criminal prosecution, immediate loss of allotted seat without any notice whatsoever, forfeiture of fees paid and levy of penalty and will be liable to be debarred from all exams / counseling in future; the authorities may also recommend blacklisting of the candidate to **NMC / DCI / KMC** and cancellation of medical / dental council registration.

11 . Compulsory Rural Service for one year:

All the candidates (other than the candidates who have undergone compulsory rural service after award of MBBS degree) who take admission to PG Medical Degree/Diploma courses in *Government / Private / Deemed colleges under Government quota or Private quota or NRI quota or Management quota* and successfully complete the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma shall under go one-year compulsory service in Government hospital in urban area as per Karnataka Compulsory service training by the candidates completed medical courses (counseling, allotment, and certification) as per Karnataka Compulsory Service Training by Candidates completed Medical Courses Act, 2012 as amended and rules there under. Please note that candidates will be entitled to only temporary registration till completion of such service.

12. Candidates selecting Government seats {including All India quota (AIQ)} in Post Graduate Medical Courses shall furnish an undertaking that he shall serve the Government for a minimum period of three years after completion of the course, if Government desires:

2. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Mere registration does not entitle a candidate to allotment of seat. He / She must fulfill the conditions of eligibility by producing the required original documents.

The eligibility of candidates for admission shall be regulated by Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for Selection and Admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma Courses Rules 2006 as amended from time to time for Government seats and such other directions issued by Government of Karnataka / Director Medical Education, Karnataka / PG Entrance Test Committee as shown below.

- (i) Candidate should have scored more than or equal to the prescribed minimum score in NEET- PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024. (Annexure 3 & 4)
- (ii) Candidate should have completed his/her MBBS/BDS courses from recognized institute by MCI/DCI respectively.
- (iii) He/ She has completed or is completing 'Compulsory Rotating Internship' on or before 30-06-2024 for MDS and 15-08-2024 for MD/MS. (Annexure 18)
- (iv) For In-service candidates the age limit is 48 years as on 31st March 2024.
- (v) Please note that SC / ST / OBC / Linguistic minority eligibility criteria are applicable to as per State Government policy only. However, if any OBC candidate of Karnataka has not claimed OBC in NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 can claim respective category in NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 in KEA.
- (vi) Any candidate, who is already holding a PG Degree in any clinical specialty, shall not be eligible for admission to any Post Graduate Degree or Diploma Course.

Any candidate who has obtained his / her undergraduate medical / dental qualifications from medical / dental Colleges outside India should have qualified in the **Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (FMGE - Screening Test)** which is conducted by National Board of Examinations / DCI (Document mandatorily to be produced). Further, they should have been registered with MCI / DCI and should have completed their internship or likely to complete their internship on or before 30-06-2024 for MDS and 15-08-2024 for MD/MS.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

Foreign national's qualification should be duly registered with appropriate registering authority in his / her own country where from he / she has obtained his / her basic medical graduate qualification, and is duly recognized by the corresponding Medical Council or concerned authority. Further, should obtain temporary registration certificate for the duration of the PG course from MCI / DCI.

Those who register with KEA through online will be eligible for verification of documents. The results / ranks published by National Board of Examination (NBE), New Delhi will be taken into consideration for preparation of list.

NOTE ON OPTION ENTRY

The option entry will be only once for all online seat allotment rounds. Candidates are required to note that there could be seat surrenders from All India Quota after the All India Quota last round or may be new approvals for additional intake and new courses approval in colleges at a later date. Candidates have to compulsorily declare the same to start option entry. Therefore all the candidates are hereby informed to enter their priority of options irrespective of the number of seats shown against a particular course.

The priority of options entered by the candidate for the first round will remain same for all the rounds of seat allotment. ***Candidates will not be allowed to enter options again for any other rounds.*** The priority of options entered by the candidate will be shown on the option entry module by obtaining the candidate credentials. Candidate may delete or alter the order of options based on the **CHOICE** of candidate opted after the respective round of seat allotment.

3. CLASSIFICATION OF SEATS

These seats are classified into four categories namely;

1. G- Government Seats
2. P- Private Seats
3. N- NRI Seats
4. Q- Others Seats

1. (G): GOVERNMENT SEATS,

Means and includes seats in Government colleges and Government share of seats in Private colleges.

- (i) 50% of Seats in Government colleges (Remaining 50% through All India Quota counseling by MCC)
- (ii) 33% of Seats in Private Non-Minority colleges.
- (iii) 20% of Seats in Private Minority (Religious & Linguistic) colleges
- (iv) 40% of Seats in Private University colleges

2. (P): PRIVATE SEATS,

Means seats in Private Colleges (KPCF, AMPCK, and KRLMPCA)

- (i) In KPCF Colleges: 42% seats reserved as private quota seats
 - **GMP seats:** For 50% of the above 42% seats. (Referred as **GMP** seats / **GMP** with Hyd-Kar seats in case of colleges located in Hyd-Kar region).
 - **OPN seats:** Remaining 50% of the above 42% seats are "OPEN" quota seats: These seats are filled based on NEET PG All India merit and only Citizens of India are eligible.
- (ii) In KRLMPCA and AMPCK Colleges: 55% of seats reserved as private quota seats.
 - 66% of the above seats will be filled by respective religious / linguistic minority candidates (MK, MA, ME, MU, MC, MM seats).
 - 34% of the above seats
 - a. **GMP:** 50% of the above 34% seats are GMP seats.
 - b. **OPN:** 50% of the above 34% seats are reserved for All India candidates who are Citizen of India (OPN seats).
 - In case of Private University 40% of the seats reserved as private quota seats.

Note: St. John's Medical college eligibility and other details are also appended to information Bulletin under the heading "**St. John's Medical College**".

3. (N): NRI SEATS,

Means 15% of the total seats reserved for NRI quota in KPCF, KRLMPCA, AMPCK colleges and private university.

4. (Q): OTHER SEATS,

Means 10% of the total seats reserved for others in KPCF, KRLMPCA & AMPCK colleges and 5% in private university.

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 ELIGIBILITY for Government seats (G) seats:

- (a) A candidate must be a citizen of India; and
- (b) have studied and passed MBBS/BDS in a recognized Medical /Dental institution in the state of Karnataka; or
- (c) have studied and passed MBBS/BDS in recognized Medical / Dental institutions located in India and has studied for a minimum period of ten academic years commencing from 1st standard to 12th standard and must have appeared and passed either SSLC or 10th standard or 2nd PUC or 12th standard equivalent examination from the Karnataka State are eligible.”

In case of the candidate who has taken more than one year to pass a class or standard, the years of academic study is counted as one year only

Note: Children for the purpose of the rule means Natural born son / daughter and not adopted son/daughter and not grandson / granddaughter.

For the purpose of document verification and eligibility the following clauses shall be used.

4.2 ELIGIBILITY for Private seats

(GMP, OPN & MK, MA, ME, MU, MC, MM seats):

A. GMP

A candidate who fulfills the eligibility as per criteria clause b/c.

B. OPN

A candidate who is citizen of India; and have studied and passed MBBS / BDS in a recognized Medical / Dental institution.

C. For Religious Minority:

- i. Christian Minority of Karnataka* & Non-Karnataka.
- ii. Muslim Minority of Karnataka* & Non- Karnataka.

*Christian and Muslim minority candidates of clause b/c are considered as Karnataka Religious minority candidate.

** Karnataka Religious minority candidates will be considered first; then, non-Karnataka religious minority candidates if any will be considered later.

D. Linguistic Minority (MA, ME, MK, MU):

- i) Linguistic Minority Reservation is applicable to persons belonging to linguistic minority of the Karnataka state whose mother tongue is Tamil or Telugu or Kodava or Tulu; and
- ii) A candidate who has studied and passed in one or more Government or Government recognized, educational institutions located in the State of Karnataka for a minimum period of TEN academic years commencing from 1st standard to 12th and must have appeared and passed either SSLC/10th standard or 2nd PUC/12th standard examination from Karnataka State.

E. St. John's Medical college, Bangalore:

Category-1.	Roman Catholic Religious Nuns with SJMC approved two year rural service.

4.3 ELIGIBILITY for NRI seats(N):

- i. Has obtained MBBS or BDS degree in a Medical or Dental in recognized institutions which should be approved by MCI / DCI.
- ii. All NRI / NRI Wards / PIO / OCI candidates and Foreign Nationals.
- iii. Children of Non-resident Indian or their Wards. (As per Hon'ble High Court in WP Nos.17999-18002/2017)
- iv. Relationship of NRI with the candidate as per the court orders of The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(c) No. 689/2017- Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. dated 22-08- 2017.
- v. As per the definition defined in The Karnataka Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) Act, 2006 read with the Karnataka Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) (Amendment) Act, 2017 and the Income Tax Act 1961 Section 115 C (e) & 6, i.e., " Non Resident Indian" means an individual resident outside India who is a citizen of India or is a Person of Indian Origin and includes Persons of Indian Origin and Overseas Citizens of India.

4.4 ELIGIBILITY for Other seats (Q):

Has studied MBBS or BDS degree in a Medical or Dental colleges affiliated to any University established by law in India recognized by Medical Council of India or Dental Council of India and Government of India. All the candidates who have qualified in NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 are eligible except NRI / PIO / OCI and Foreign Nationals.

5. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED

The Karnataka Examinations Authority or the Entrance Test Committee may from time to time specify for submission such other additional documents and issue directions as deemed essential for all candidates for maintaining absolute transparency and integrity in the document verification process, determination of eligibility and seat allotment and admission - through a notification on the website of KEA / updates on MCI / MCC.

10. Certificate from the head of institute certifying that the Medical / Dental College from which the candidate has passed MBBS/BDS examination is recognized by MCI/DCI.
11. State / Central Medical / Dental Council Registration Certificate. [Provisional registration certificate will be accepted only for the candidates who have passed MBBS / BDS during 2024. Permanent State / Central Medical / Dental Council Registration Certificate to be compulsorily submitted at the time of admission process. (Candidates who have passed prior to 2024, should compulsorily possess the Original Permanent Registration certificate and upload the same)]
12. Eligibility Certificate (Other University)
13. All the candidates are also required to produce UNDERTAKING (**Annexure 7**), taken on a white paper. Further the same undertaking obtained on Rs. 20 e-Stamps Paper brought out in the name of the candidate to the Karnataka Examinations Authority as shown in (**Annexure 7**), only on submission of this document, candidate's admission process is stated to be completed and he /she becomes eligible for admission /allotment of User ID and Secret Key.

371(j) (Hyderabad-Karnataka Region) certificate - If applicable, Certificates issued by the competent authority for claiming reservation under 371(j) (Hyderabad-Karnataka Region). (**Annexure-8**) should be uploaded.

NOTE: Indian citizens or Overseas Citizens of India who have obtained their Primary Medical Qualifications from Medical Colleges outside India should have qualified in the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (Screening Test) which is conducted by National Board of Examinations - Document mandatorily to be uploaded. Further, they should have been registered with MCI / SMC and should have completed their internship or likely to complete their internship on or before 30-06-2024 for MDS and 15-08-2024 for MD/MS. **(Annexure 18)**

Other mandatory certificates:

14. Eligibility Certificate by RGUHS for the candidates graduated from other university other than RGUHS (To be submitted at the respective admitted college).
15. Migration certificate from the concerned University if MBBS / BDS done from other than RGUHS, Bangalore. (To be submitted at the respective admitted college).
16. Compulsory rural service bond on Rs.100/- stamp paper **(Annexure 1)** and undertaking for three years service on Rs 200/- stamp paper duly notarized **(Annexure 2)**. (to be submitted at the time of admission process)

Apart from the above documents, the other documents to be compulsorily produced by the candidates based on their eligibility clauses (as per SI No. 5).

- iv) In case of claiming reservation benefits: Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahsildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-1 in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in Form-F (In case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband name & income of spouse (Ref G.O no DPAR 20 SBC 82, Dtd 28/12/1983).

- a) "In-Service Candidates" means persons belonging to the Health & Family Welfare Services, Employees State Insurance (Medical) Services, Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike, Boards and Corporations, and institutions which are granted autonomous status including the persons deputed from such services to any other foreign services. As per G.O. No. HFW. 334. RGU.2012 dated 22.12.2012 ESIC Doctors working in Karnataka are considered as In-service Doctors and their seat allocation will be done under the quota of Boards & Corporations.
- b) For In-service candidates the age limit is 48 years as on 31st March 2024.
- c) In service candidates should obtain **NOC (No Objection Certificate)** from Head of the concerned department and enter the relevant details in the registration form, further the same NOC should be produced at the time of verifying the documents.
- d) The in-service doctors have to fulfill the following conditions stipulated under Rule 10 of Karnataka conduct of Entrance Test for admission to Post-Graduate Medical Degree and Diploma Courses Rules 2006 as amended from time to time.
- e) The Head of the Departments should forward the applications of only such candidates who fulfill all the criteria mentioned in the application form.
- f) Advance copies from candidates will not be entertained.

g) In-service candidate shall be eligible for admission under these rules:

1. In-Service candidate who has completed three years of regular service after the successful completion of probationary period (as on 31st March in which the Entrance Test is held) shall be eligible for admission under these rules and is eligible to apply for the Common Entrance Test and to participate in the counseling.
 2. In-service candidate shall be eligible for admission to Post-Graduate Degree and Diploma courses in any subject.
 3. An in-service candidate who is already holding a Postgraduate Diploma in any specialty shall be eligible for Postgraduate Degree Course in any specialty.
 4. Studying in any Post-Graduate Degree or Diploma course shall not be eligible for admission under these rules.
 5. If they have any Departmental enquires against them.
 6. Incomplete and incorrect applications are liable for rejection. No changes will be entertained after the submission of application.
- h) In addition to the above, In-service doctors should furnish the information sought in the application form and the heads of the departments should verify and forward the applications to the DME who will in turn forward them to The Executive Director, Karnataka Examinations Authority, Malleshwaram, 18th Cross, Bangalore (for verification of documents). The Concerned Heads of Department i.e., Directors / Heads of Autonomous Institutions in respect of Medical Education, Health and Family Welfare Services, BBMP, ESI (S), ESIC and Heads of other Boards and Corporations should verify and approve the details entered by the candidates online through the KEA portal for NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 with the credentials provided.
- i) The seats within the in-service quota shall be reserved as per the MCI / DCI / Government issued from time to time. Any seats reserved for In- Service Candidates which shall remain un-filled for want of eligible candidate or otherwise shall be added to the non-in service quota seats as per Government / DME instructions.
- j) Department wise reservation of seats shall not be permitted.

(1) REGISTRATION OF A CANDIDATE

Every candidate who is registered with KEA for PG Medical / Dental admissions will have to report to KEA, Bangalore as per the schedule for Registration and Verification of Documents. The PGET No. will be entered in to the computer by verifying with NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 Score Card 2024 / Admission Ticket and candidate photo printed on the valid Identity Card of the Candidate.

Interaction Session: An Interaction Session will be conducted at the centre. At this stage candidates will be briefed about the procedure to be followed by the candidate in exercising options, allotment of seats, payment of fees and reporting to the college. This will be like a training class to the candidates to familiarize themselves on entry of options and procedure to be followed for such entry of options till their admissions to the college.

(2) VERIFICATION OF ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS

After Registration, the candidates will be allowed to proceed towards the Verification Counter/s where the entries of original documents are verified against the computer data that would have been furnished by them in their application forms. **After verification, the original documents will be returned to the candidate and KEA will retain one set of attested photocopies of all the documents.** Before leaving the verification counter, an acknowledgment card and a verification slip will be issued to the candidates.

The candidates will have to get their original documents verified to be eligible for Option Entry for choice of allotment of PG Medical / Dental seat.

Candidates who seek admission to PG Medical / PG Dental seats should compulsorily produce the required documents in ORIGINAL with ONE set of photocopies of all the original documents and two passport size photographs for verification at the KEA at the time of registration for allotment of seats. After verification, only ONE set of photocopies of all the documents will be retained by the KEA and all original documents will be returned to the candidates.

No individual intimation will be sent to the eligible rank holders regarding the date and time of verification process. The original documents to be produced during verification have been detailed in the previous pages under each of the Eligibility Clauses.

(3) VERIFICATION SCHEDULE

The candidate should compulsorily bring all necessary original documents in support of their claim when they come for verification without fail. If any candidate fails to produce any of the documents / certificates / marks card on the day of verification, such candidate's documents will not be verified and they will not complete their registration process and subsequently will not be considered for eligibility to exercise their options.

(4) NOTE ON VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

No changes / claims will be accepted once the documents are verified and verification slip is issued to the candidate for any reason. The candidates are informed to verify the entries printed on the verification slip and the acknowledgement card before leaving the verification counter. If there is any mistake / error, then report to Verification Officer for correction. The candidate who becomes eligible after verification will only be considered for entry of options and for allotment of seats. All the details printed on the verification slip will be considered for allotment of seats. Eligibility of candidate for consideration of seat allotment totally depends on the production of all supporting documents at the time of verification which inter leads to correctness of data of candidates. Therefore, the candidate is also jointly responsible for ensuring the correctness of the data. No request for alteration of data will be considered under any circumstances at any point of time after verification of documents is completed.

(5) SECRET KEY: The candidate who becomes eligible after verification of documents will be given high security secret key, the candidate has to use this secret key to register and create a password as per his/her choice for login at online option entry portal. For any reason secret key and Password should not be made known or revealed to others as it might enable modification / tampering options. The Candidate will solely be responsible for maintaining secrecy of the Password and secret key. KEA will not take any responsibility in this regard. Password is important and shall be held confidentially. It is as important as the PIN of ATM card. Password is essential for candidate's login, entry of options, change of options, saving and deletion of options and for printing of allotment details.

Using this User ID and secret key the candidate has to coin his/her own password for further processes namely option entry ,viewing of online seat allotment details ,etc. For any reason User ID and Secret key should not be made known or revealed to others as it might enable modification / tampering the data. The Candidate will solely be responsible for maintaining secrecy of the Password and KEA will not take any responsibility in this regard. Secret key is important and should be held confidentially. It is as important as the PIN of ATM card.

5. OPTION ENTRY STEPS:

(i) Seat Matrix

The KEA will publish the seat matrix as received from the Government before the commencement of allotment of seats in the first round. For the benefit of candidates, complete list of colleges and subjects has been provided in the information bulletin and further details about colleges can be obtained from Medical/Dental Council of India website.

(ii) Entry of Options by Candidates

1. Before entering the options for PG Medical or dental course and subject, please note that each college will have four different categories of seats. (Except Government Colleges where in only G seats)
 - a. Government Share of seats in Government and Private colleges - "G" seats
 - b. Private seats "P" seats
 - c. NRI seats "N" seats
 - d. Others "Q" seats
2. Likewise please note that each category of seats has a separate fee structure (Government, Private, NRI, Others)
3. The college codes ending with "... MG" are indicating Government seats in Government and Government quota seats in Private Colleges; the college codes ending with "...MP" are indicating Private seats; the college codes ending with "...MN" are indicating NRI seats and the college codes ending with "...MQ" are indicating the Other seats.
4. Types of candidates who are eligible to enter the options for different types of category of seats in a college, please read the eligibility.
5. Candidates should make a note of permitted and recognized status of the each seat before entering the options. (Visit MCI / DCI / KEA Website for more details).
6. Entry of options by the candidates will begin as per the calendar of events notified. The details of College, Course, Subject, Category and discipline available for allotment will be published on <http://kea.kar.nic/pget2024.htm>
7. The candidate may enter the course / college of his choice from among the seats available which is displayed at the time of entry of options i.e., discipline wise (Medical / Dental), course wise (Masters / Diploma), college wise.
8. The candidate will have the choice to enter all the options in the discipline to which he/she is eligible irrespective of the availability of seats.

- a. **The option entry will be only once** for all online seat allotment rounds. Candidates are required to note that there could be seat surrenders from All India Quota after the All India Quota last round or as well as may be new approvals for additional intake and new courses approval in colleges at a later date. Candidates have to compulsorily declare the same to start option entry. Therefore all the candidates are hereby informed to enter their priority of options irrespective of the number of seats shown against a particular course.
- b. Candidate can enter the options for one of the discipline for which he/she is eligible. Upon entry of preliminary information by the candidate in the option entry, the option entry form will be displayed.
- c. The entry form contains priority order number, discipline, college name, college code, and the subject code. The candidate has to give the priority order number from among the list of colleges and courses. Candidate can prioritize his/her options from series of permutation/combination of college and course.
- d. There is no limit for entry of options. A candidate can enter any number of options as he / she wishes to exercise on his / her own priority. Candidates are advised to enter more number of options to avoid any disappointment of not securing a seat.
- e. Candidate has to enter the option in the order of priority as he / she desires. Candidates are advised to do thorough home assignment regarding the choices which they want to exercise, the college which they prefer, the course which they are interested to join etc. It is better to write the order of options on a sheet of white paper and discuss the same with your parents / guardians / mentors etc before actually entering same in the system.
- f. Candidate interest in the college infrastructure, course, distance from your place, availability of hostel, fees, stipend etc may be some of the issues to guide your choices of options and advice of your parents. As it will save your time and minimize your chance of making mistake in option entry on the online option entry form.
- g. Candidate must take printout of the options entered for further references.
- h. The allotment will not proceed to the next rank candidate till the list of your options is completely searched for availability of a seat. The candidate may change the options as many times as he / she desires before the last date and time notified for entry of options. After entry of options candidate has to select the button submit and logout.

Candidates should be very cautious while filling Option Entries:

All the PG Medical/Dental aspirants are informed to remember the following important points while entering the Options/Priorities of courses and colleges for seat selection to PG admission.

- All PG Medical/Dental seats are classified into four types as given below
 - Government seats in Government colleges as well as private colleges – Govt (G)
 - Private quota Seats in Private colleges - Private(P),
 - Non Resident Indian seats - NRI -(N)
 - Others seats - Other(Q)
- All the seats are notified with six characters as given below

Entry of options

Allotment of seats is based on the merit and the priority of options entered by the candidates; hence the candidates are advised to prepare a list of colleges and courses which they are interested to select, candidates are advised not to enter options without any preparation or without consulting their parents. Preferential list should be followed while entering the options. Detailed instructions on How to enter options for allotment of seats with examples are given for the information of the candidates.

Candidates are advised to check KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> everyday for latest updates.

- The above mentioned seat notification code would be displayed with fees details during the Option entry after login to system based on the eligibility of the each candidate

- The Seat allotment logic/module/system follows the Category, NEET Rank of the candidate along with the entered options and priorities given by the candidate during options entry
- Assume that a candidate is eligible under for G & GMP seats, then, he/she would be eligible to enter options related to G-Seats, P-Seats and Q-Seats of all colleges
- If he/she entered Options with the priorities as given below, then the system would check the seat availability as per the options & priorities and allot the seat if it is available at that point in time [as explained below]

In the above scenario, the system would check the seat availability for the above four options one by one starting from the priority No. 1 to 4 in order and would allot seat based on the availability. Assume that the candidate is having required merit/rank to avail any seat of the above four options including the G-Seats of option/priority no. 3 or 4, where the fees is lower as compare to the P-Seat/Q-Seat. The system would allot seat only against option/priority No. 01 as seat is available as per his/her merit/rank and he/she has not given G-Seats in the top. Therefore, all the candidates are informed to be very cautious while filling option entries & priority as there is no provision to change the seat in the later stage once seat is allotted.

(iii) RESERVATION OF SEATS IN FAVOR OF CERTAIN CATEGORIES:

a. Hyderabad Karnataka reservation policy:

Local person: Any person claiming reservation as local person shall obtain eligibility certificate issued by competent authority. A candidate for admission to any course of study shall be regarded as a local person in relation to the Local area as explained in Para 4 of the "The Karnataka educational Institutions (regulations of admission in the Hyderabad Karnataka Region) Order 2013.

The reservation of seats in respect of local persons: Regional institutes including Government, Private, private unaided and deemed universities shall reserve 70% of available seats for local persons every year after deducting the seats allocated to All India quota/NRI quota in every course of study and State wide institutions shall reserve 8% of available seats for local persons every year after deducting the seats allocated to All India quota/NRI quota

Reservation for local person shall be calculated based on the total number of seats available in an institution shall be made on rotation wise and specialty wise every year.

The reservation of seats in respect of local persons shall be applicable to all the courses run by all the institutions listed in the notification No HFW 380 RGU 2013, Bangalore, dated 01/02/2014

Horizontal and vertical reservation policy will be applicable to seats in Government Institutions and for the Government quota seats in Private institutions.

b. Reservation for Persons with disabilities:

5% of the Government seats will be reserved in favor of Persons with disabilities. **PWD Reservations:** Eligibility for Benchmark Disabilities is as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016.

PWD reservation is applicable to Karnataka candidates only. All the candidates' needs to attend medical examination compulsorily on the dates notified later.

NOTE: Before applying under PWD, ensure that you are eligible as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016.

Candidates will be disqualified at any stage of admission, if they found not-eligible as per Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016.

Reservation for SC, ST and OBC's category:

Reservation is made in favor of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes of citizens under categories 1, 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in accordance with Government Order No. SWL 251 BCA 94 dated 31st January 1995, as amended from time to time.

Production of a "Caste Certificate / Caste Income Certificate" issued by the concerned Jurisdictional Tahshildar in accordance with the Government order No. Sa Ka E 225 BCA 2002 dated 30th March 2002 and No. Sa Ka E 104 BCA 2011 dated 06-02-2012 as amended from time to time, in Form 'D' in case of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes; in Form 'E' in case of Category-I; in Form 'F' in case of Other Backward Classes like 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in support of the claim is mandatory for selecting a seat under reserved category.

Provided that candidates belonging to SC, ST & Category - I should produce an Income certificate issued by Jurisdictional Tahshildar in the prescribed format.

SC / ST / OBC reservation is applicable only to Karnataka SC / ST /OBC candidates.

c. Reservation for Religious & Linguistic Minority Category:

Reservation is made in favour of candidates belonging to linguistic / religious minority as per Government minority rules in selected colleges.

(iv) **COUNSELING PROCEDURE (ALLOTMENT LOGIC)**

The seat matrix issued by the Government for each discipline will be adopted for allotment seats. College wise, course wise and category wise seat matrix issued by Government will be hosted on the KEA website for the information of the candidates and parents. The online allotment will be based on merit, priority of options entered by the candidate and roster prescribed by the Government.

Eligibility to participate in each round is subject to the conditions stipulated from time to time by MCC. KEA will not be held responsible in this regard. The online allotment of seats will be conducted in multiple numbers of iterations.

1. First Round.
2. Second Round.
3. Mop-up Round.
4. Stray Vacancy Round (subject to availability of seats)

a. Order of online seat allotment in first round:

- a) Persons with benchmark disabilities
- b) Common merit list of in-service & non in-service candidates

The seat will be allotted to the eligible candidates as per the roster system and seat matrix issued by the Government and based on the options entered by the candidates.

b. Procedure for allotment of seats in Medical / Dental Discipline:

The computer starts with allotment of seats to rank number 1 in Medical discipline. The computer first checks the availability of seats for the First option entered by the candidate with Rank no 1. Obviously the candidate will get the seat as per his options. Whereas for the next rank holders the computer check the availability of seats for the first option, if seat is available it will allot or if the seat is not available then the computer will search for the next option. Like that the computer will search for the availability of seats for all the options entered by the candidates. The computer will stop searching for allotment of seats once the seat is allotted then the computer will move on to next eligible candidates. Similarly the computer will search for all the candidates based on the merit and options. Like this the computer will reach the last rank till seats are exhausted or till last rank candidate is reached. This entire process is called iteration.

c. Seat Allotment Logic:

Based on the seat matrix issued by the Government, action will be taken to allot the seats to the candidates based on their eligibility and reservation criteria. The options entered by the candidate will be considered for allotment based on the merit. While allotting the seats to the candidates, the computer will check the availability of seats for each option based on the priority of options. The order of allotment / reservation for each of the category is detailed below for the information of the candidates.

The allotment of seat for a particular candidate is based on his/her rank and priority option entered. In any category, the candidate option is searched in general category (GM) and allotted, if no seat is available in GM category the computer searches in Hyderabad Karnataka GM quota (GMH) and allots the seat. If seat is not available either in GM or GMH then it follows the priority order as shown above. This improves the category of seat allotted to roster. In the same manner all the categories improved as per roster for candidates claiming reservation.

d. Order of online seat allotment in Second round will be notified later.

Eligibility to participate in each round is subject to the conditions stipulated from time to time by MCC. KEA will not be held responsible in this regard.

NOTE: The instructions and guidelines issued by the Competent Authority from time to time shall be followed.

NOTE:

The candidates who allotted seat either in first round or in the second round should compulsorily report to the selected college as the seat allotment is based on the priority of options entered by the candidates. Mere not reporting to the selected college will not be presumed by the candidates that they have surrendered the seat to KEA and it is tantamount of blocking of seat and it attracts the penalty. Further, Government may initiate legal action against such candidates for blocking the seats.

(v) Post Allotment Procedures.

The First Round seat allotment list will be hosted on the Website. Candidate should login and exercise any one of the 4 choices:

The choices are: -

a. Choice 1

“Satisfied with the allotted seat and candidate is willing to report to the allotted college, not interested in further allotment of seats in any subsequent round for any discipline”.

Such candidates should undergo Biometric verification, pay the prescribed fees and submit the original documents, obtain the admission order and report to the college on or before last date as specified in the admission order. He/she should login to their Option Entry Log-In-Id and report to KEA that they have joined. If a candidate fails to report back to KEA that they have joined, then their seat will be cancelled even though they might have physically joined.

Further any candidate who has paid the fees and obtained the Admission Order and fails to report to the College on or before the last date and time specified by KEA in the admission Order, for such candidates no extension of time will be given and the allotment made in his favor shall be treated as cancelled and he / she has no claim further on such allotment and they will not be considered for allotment of seats in the subsequent round. Such seats shall revert back to the pool and fee paid by them will be forfeited.

Implication: Not eligible to participate in the subsequent rounds.

Important: Before opting for this choice candidate is advised to be sure as he / she cannot come back to Option Entry Process for NEET-PG 2024 / NEET MDS 2024 admissions.

The candidates who exercise Choice 1 should follow the guidelines detailed below:

- The candidate has to confirm that he / she is satisfied with the allotted seat in the first round.
- Then candidate has to make the payment by following procedures prescribed in the following pages.
- After ascertaining the payment, candidates will be allowed to submit the original documents.
- **After making the payment candidate has to submit the original documents to KEA on the specified dates.**
- Collect the Admission Order from KEA and report to the college on or before the last date mentioned in the Admission Order.
- After reporting to the college update the joining status details on the KEA Web Portal that candidate has reported to the college.
- Inform the college authority to log on to College Portal to enter the candidate reported details.

Note:

The Choice 1 candidate who fails to produce any one of the original document or all the documents or who fails to pay the fees, for such candidates the seat allotted to them in the first round stands cancelled automatically and also such candidates will not be considered for further round of seat allotment.

b. Choice2

Candidate is satisfied with the allotted seat but wishes to participate in the next round. Such candidates should pay the prescribed fees and wait for the schedule to submit the original documents after undergoing Biometric verification and wait for allotment in second round. No admission order will be given. If there is provision for up gradation of candidates option entry, seat will be allotted in second round and then earlier allotted seat gets cancelled automatically. If no seat is allotted in the second round then earlier allotted seat will still holds good in the favor of candidate.

Implication: Eligible to participate in the subsequent round keeping the seat allotted on hold. However, if other seat gets allotted in the second round the candidate loses his old seat. There is no choice between the seats of first and second round.

The candidates who exercise Choice 2 should follow the guidelines detailed below:

- The candidate has to confirm that he / she is satisfied with the allotted seat in the first round. The candidate who exercises Choice 2 have to compulsorily pay the fees by following procedures prescribed in the following pages.
- After ascertaining the payment, candidates will be allowed to submit the original documents on the dates specified at a later date.

- After making the payment candidate has to submit the original documents to KEA on the specified dates.
- Candidate shall not join the allotted college for the seat allotted in the first round they have to wait for the second round seat allotment.
- The seat allotted the candidate in the first round will be considered as last option in the second round.

NOTE:

The candidate will not have any Choice to exercise in round 2. The Choice 2 candidates are participating in the second round by holding a seat allotted in the first round. Further, If the seat is upgraded in the second round then the candidate has to collect the admission order and report to the college.

If the seat is not upgraded in the second round then the seat allotted to them in the first round will be confirmed and the candidate has to collect the admission order and report to the college on or before the last date mentioned in the Admission Order.

After reporting to the college update the joining status details on the KEA Web Portal that candidate has reported to the college.

Inform the college authority to log on to College Portal to enter the candidate reported details.

c. Choice 3:

The candidate is not satisfied with the present allotment and wishes to participate in the next round of counseling. The previously allotted seat is forfeited and offered to the next eligible candidate. Such candidates should wait for the schedule to submit the original documents before second round of online seat allotment and wait for second round of seat allotment. If original documents are not submitted such candidates are not eligible for second round of seat allotment.

Implication: Eligible to participate in the second round only if he/she submitted original documents and no claim on previously allotted seat.

The candidates who exercise Choice 3 should follow the guidelines detailed below:

- If the candidate is not satisfied with the allotted seat in the first round and wish to participate in the second round then he / she has to exercise Choice 3 on the KEA Web portal.
- Candidates need not pay the fees for the seat allotted in the first round.
- Candidate has to submit the original documents to KEA on the specified dates to become eligible to participate in the second round.

NOTE:

The Choice 3 candidates are participating in the second round without holding any seat. Further, if the seat is allotted in the second round then the candidate has to compulsorily pay the fees for the seat allotted. After making the payment, candidate has to collect the admission order and report to the college on or before the last date mentioned in the Admission Order. After reporting to the college update the joining status details on the KEA Web Portal that candidate has reported to the college. Inform the college authority to log on to College Portal to enter the candidate reported details. The candidate will not have any choice to exercise in second round.

d. Choice 4:

Not satisfied with KEA allotted seat and candidate has got seat elsewhere, so candidate is quitting and not to be considered for allotment of seats in any of the further rounds.

Implication: Not eligible to participate in the subsequent round and no hold on the allotted seat and seat allotted earlier will get cancelled.

NOTE:

If a candidate fails to exercise any of the above four choices or fails to follow any prescribed procedures within the stipulated date and time through KEA portal, then the seat allotted to such candidate stands cancelled automatically without any further notice in this regard and he/she shall not be allowed to participate in further rounds.

e. Choice-2 / Choice-3 / not allotted Candidates.

All the candidates who were allotted seat in the first round and opted choices 2 or 3 and also those candidates who have not been allotted a seat during first round should undergo Biometric verification, submit their original documents on notified dates to KEA before second round of online seat allotment. If any candidate fails to exercise option entry before first round he/she will not be eligible to participate in further rounds of seat allotment.

A: Additional Instructions to Choice-1 candidates

1. First, candidate has to make the payment. After making the payment candidate has to submit the original documents to KEA as per the above schedule. (Choice-1 printout, Fee paid receipt, Verification Slip, all original documents including Annexure-1, Annexure-2, Annexure-7 and one set of photocopies of all the documents)
2. Then, collect the Admission Order from KEA and report to the college on or before the last date mentioned in the Admission Order.
3. After reporting to the college update the joining status details on the KEA Web Portal that candidate has reported to the college.
4. Inform the college authority to log on to College Portal to enter the candidate reported details.

B: Instructions to candidates who have exercised Choice-2 in the first round.

1. Candidate has to pay the fees for the seat allotted to them in the first round.
2. Candidates have to wait for the schedule to submit the original documents to KEA to become eligible for the second round. Schedule for submission original documents will be notified on the KEA Website. (Choice-2 printout, Fee paid receipt, Verification Slip, all original documents including Annexure-1, Annexure-2, Annexure-7 and one set of photocopies of all the documents)
3. Candidate shall not join the allotted college for the seat allotted in the first round they have to wait for the second round seat allotment.
4. The seat allotted the candidate in the first round will be considered as last option in the second round.

Additional Instructions to Choice-2 candidates

- Candidates who have exercised Choice-2 in first round are participating in the second round by holding the seat allotted to them in the first round.
- All the higher order options will be displayed on the option entry screen.
- Candidates can alter, modify, delete or re-order the higher order options.
- Higher order options means, presume that the candidate has entered 76 options, and if the seat is allotted for his / her priority number 45 in the first round, then the priority number 1 to 44 are the higher order options.
- If higher order options are allotted to them, the earlier seat will automatically stand cancelled. OR
- If any of the Higher Order Options are not allotted, then the seat allotted to them in the first round will remain with the candidate.

Additional Important Instructions for First Round Choice 2 Candidates

- (a) The Choice 2 candidates are participating by holding a seat allotted in the First Round, if any seat is allotted to them in the second round, then their First Round seat gets added to the seat matrix immediately and is offered to the next eligible candidates in the order of options and priority of options.
- (b) While modifying the order of options or deleting the options candidates are advised to give only such options that are better than his / her allotted seat. If the modified option gets allotted they lose their old seat. If none of the seats are available then the candidate's earlier seat is retained.
- (c) For Choice 2 candidates the seat allotted in the First Round will be considered as last option. The Choice 2 candidates should be very careful while submitting the options. One should understand that the seat allotted in the First Round will become the last option, it means all the higher options saved by the candidates will be treated as options for seat allotment.

(d) All the higher order options will be displayed for entry of options, if any candidate is intending to retain the same seat which is allotted in the First Round, then he / she has to delete all such options which is displayed on the option entry portal, then the seat allotted in the First Round will be retained in this round also.

Additional Instructions to candidates who have exercised Choice-3 in first round.

1. Candidates need not pay the fees for the seat allotted to them in the first round.
2. Candidates have to wait for the schedule to submit the original documents to become eligible for the second round. Schedule for submission of original documents will be notified on the KEA Website. (Choice-3 printout, Verification Slip, all original documents including Annexure-1, Annexure-2, Annexure-7 and one set of photocopies of all the documents)
3. Choice-3 candidates are participating in this round without holding any seat allotted to them in the first round, if any seat is allotted to them in this round then such seat will be confirmed in their favour or if no seat is allotted to them then they will not be having any seat in their favour.
4. All the already entered options except the allotted option will be displayed on the option entry screen.
5. Candidates can alter, modify, delete or re-order the already entered options.

Additional Important Instructions for First Round Choice 3 Candidates

While modifying the order of options or deleting the options, candidates are advised to give only such options that are better than his / her allotted seat and for those options candidates are willing to join the college / course in case the seat is allotted.

Additional Instructions to candidates who have not been allotted any seat in the first round.

Candidates have to submit the original documents to become eligible to participate in the second round. Schedule for submission of original documents will be notified on the KEA Website. (Verification Slip, all original documents including Annexure-1, Annexure-2, Annexure-7 and one set of photocopies of all the documents)

FEE PAYMENT AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The tuition fees structure for various colleges and courses has been hosted on the KEA Website for the information of the candidates. For payment of fees candidate has to follow any one of the following procedure:

- Through Challan: Downloading the specific Challan from the KEA Website and make the payment at the prescribed bank (The candidates who have allotted seats with fee structure less than One Lakh have to follow this procedure)
- Through Net Banking: By logging on to the KEA Portal and transferring the fee amount by using Internet Banking / Debit / Credit Card. (with limitation of transfer of amount)
- Through NEFT / Other Bank Challan: Log on to KEA Portal and obtain candidate's Unique / Virtual Account Number by downloading the NEFT / Other Bank Challan, transfer the fee amount to that Account Number OR make the payment in any bank in person.

Appeal to Candidates

Candidates may have options of selecting the seats in other boards / colleges / states outside KEA also. Such candidates may please note that such of those who have got the Allotment Order from KEA and do not join the allotted college or leave the college after joining would be tantamount to seat blocking and will result in loss of subsidized Government Quota / Private Seats and unlawful gain to the Private Managements. There are other equally eligible meritorious candidates in the merit queue. KEA requests such candidates to surrender their allotted seat to KEA only and such seat will be offered to other equally eligible meritorious candidates in the Second Round.

The candidates who have,

(a) exercised Choice-1 in the first round, submitted the original documents, paid the fees, collected the Admission Order and reported to the college;

or

(b) exercised Choice-2 in the first round submitted the original documents and paid the fees, may have the chance of joining to the college or courses from other boards later on, are hereby informed to surrender their seat on or before the last date fixed for entry of options for the second round.

Candidates may please note that, such of those who do not join the allotted college or leave the college after joining - such actions are tantamount to seat blocking and will result in loss of subsidized Government Quota seats to the Private Management. (There are other equally eligible meritorious candidates in the merit queue.) Such candidates should surrender their allotted seat to KEA only and such seat will be offered to other equally eligible meritorious candidates in the Second Round.

Submission of original documents to attend 2nd Round of seat allotment is mandatory. It is further stated that no excuse will be entertained if original documents are not deposited. The time and date for submission of documents will be notified in the website of KEA for Choice 2, Choice 3 and seat not allotted candidates.

(vi) **SECOND ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT:**

Eligibility to participate in each round is subject to the conditions stipulated from time to time by MCC. KEA will not be held responsible in this regard.

a. The following types of seats are made available for second round seat allotment.

- a. Unfilled seats of First Round.
- b. Choice 3 seats of First Round.
- c. Choice 4 seats of First Round.
- d. Exercised Choice 1 in First Round but failed to make payment or not joined the college.
- e. Exercised Choice 2 in First Round but failed to make payment.
- f. Cancelled / Surrendered seats.
- g. Candidates allotted seats in First Round but failed to exercise their Choice within the last date.
- h. Newly added seats if any. (All India Quota)
- i. Consequential Vacancies.

b. Types of candidates allowed for Second Round.

- a. Choice 2 candidates of First Round who have made the payment and deposited the original documents.
- b. Choice 3 candidates of First Round and deposited the original documents.
- c. Not allotted any seat in First Round and deposited the original documents.
- d. If the candidate who has been allotted a seat in Second Round of All India Quota and Deemed University and has not joined the allotted college in Round 2 of All India counseling, and exits with forfeiture clause, he/she shall be allowed to participate in 2nd round of state counseling subject to deposition of original documents at KEA.

c. The following types of candidates are not eligible to participate in the Second Round.

- a. Candidates who have failed to exercise any choice even after allotment of seats in the First Round.
- b. Candidates who have exercised Choice-2 in the First Round but failed to make the payment for the seat confirmed by them or failed to deposit the original documents.
- c. After seat allotment in the first round, candidates who have exercised Choice 1 but failed to collect the Admission Order.
- d. Choice-1 candidates of first round collected admission order but failed to report to the college.

- e. Candidates who have exercised Choice-3 in the First Round but failed to deposit the original documents.
 - f. Candidate who has not allotted any seat in the first round but failed to deposit the original documents.
 - g. After seat allotment in the first round, candidates who have exercised Choice 1 or Choice 2 and cancelled / surrendered the seats.
- d. Post allotment procedure: Implication: - Choices before a candidate.**
- a. There will be no Choice to exercise to the candidates.
 - b. Candidates who have allotted seat to any college / course are required to pay the prescribed fees (if not paid) and should compulsorily report to the colleges on or before the last date mentioned in the admission order and should update the details through their log-In-Id to KEA.
 - c. If any candidate fails to report to the college after allotment of seats in the Second Round, legal action will be initiated against such candidate in accordance with law.

NOTE:

- If the candidate does not get any seat in this round then the seat allotted to him / her in the earlier round if any stands confirmed.
- All candidates who have been allotted afresh in this round should compulsorily join the colleges after making payment and collecting admission order at KEA and report to KEA portal for confirmation otherwise seat gets cancelled.
- The fee paid by the candidates in the earlier round if any, will be adjusted upon allotment of a seat in this round.

- (3) Further, they shall be ineligible for further rounds of counseling or admissions for that academic year.

Provided that in case of cancellation after the last date of joining for second round and one day before the mop-up round a penalty of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven lakhs only) for Medical or Dental Clinical degree and Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs only) for Medical or Dental Clinical Diploma courses shall be collected.

- (4) Any cancellation or surrender of seats after the mop up round shall be made in person only to the Director, Directorate of Medical Education, Karnataka with a penalty of Rs 18,00,000/- (Rupees eighteen lakhs only) in case of Medical Clinical Degree or Diploma Courses and Rs 6,00,000/- (Rupees six lakhs only) in case of Dental Degree or Diploma Courses and forfeiture of fees paid before the last date of admission as notified. Further, they will be ineligible for further rounds of admission including names list admission.

Provided that,-

- (a) A candidate who has opted Pre-Clinical seats like Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry including Forensic Medicine in the event of cancellation shall pay a penalty of Rs. 1,00,000 (Rupees One Lakh only) and the fees paid shall be forfeited;
- (b) A candidate who has opted Para Clinical Seats like Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology and Community Medicine, in the event of cancellation, shall pay a penalty of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs only) for post graduate degree courses and Rs. 75,000/- (Rupees Seventy thousand only) for post graduate Diploma courses and the tuition fees paid shall be forfeited.

Provided further that, a non-in-service / regular candidate, cancel / surrender Medical / Dental Postgraduate degree or diploma seat after the last date admissions, he is not eligible to take management quota seat or any other quota Medical or Dental PG Degree or Diploma seat for a period of three years; and

Provided further that, in case a non-in-service / regular and in-service candidate cancel / surrender the seat before or after the last date of admission / counseling, he is not permitted / eligible for rejoining the cancelled / surrendered seat. OR fails to join the course after allotment, the candidate is not eligible to take management quota seat or any other Medical or Dental PG degree or Diploma seat for a period of three years and he shall be liable for disciplinary action.

- (5) A candidate at the time of admission shall furnish a bond in the form specified by the Government binding himself to pay a sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs only) for Medical or Dental degree and Rs. 4,00,000/- (Rupees four lakhs only) for Medical or Dental Diploma courses as a penalty in the event of his leaving the course before its completion after the last date of admission for that academic year as notified by Medical Council of India/Dental Council of India.

Provided that,-

- a. A candidate who has opted Pre-Clinical seats like Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry including Forensic Medicine in the event of leaving the course shall pay a penalty of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) and the fees paid shall be forfeited.
 - b. A candidate who has opted Para Clinical Seats like Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology and Community Medicine, in the event of leaving the course shall pay a penalty of Rs 1,00,000/- for post graduate degree courses and Rs 75,000/- (Seventy five thousand only) for post graduate Diploma courses and the tuition fees paid shall be forfeited.
- (6) In addition to the prescribed penalty under sub-rule (4), all candidates (including in-service candidates) shall pay the entire course fee and stipend to the respective Medical/Dental colleges in the event he leaving the course before its completion.

Provided further that, in case of an in-service candidate, in the event he leaves the course before its completion or the competent authority concludes that the in service candidate has not shown sufficient progress in the studies or has failed to complete the course in proper time or fails to resume duty even after the expiry of the termination of the period of deputation or at any time within a period of ten years after completion of the higher studies, it shall be lawful to the Government to make recovery of the amount (including pay and allowances, stipend, DA, tuition fee etc, along with penalty and applicable interest) spent on higher studies or specialized training from the salary of the candidate.

(7) All Candidates selecting Government seats {including All India quota (AIQ) in Post Graduate Medical Courses shall furnish an undertaking that he shall serve the Government for a minimum period of three years after completion of the course, if Government desires:

Provided that, in-service candidates at the time of admission shall furnish a bond in the form specified by the Government that they shall be rendering service in the Government for a minimum period of ten years.

(8) In case of candidate selecting Government seats, the candidate shall serve the Government for a period as specified in sub-rule (6) failing to comply, with the conditions given as per undertaking, then he shall be liable to pay a penalty of Rs. 50,00,000/- (Rupees fifty lakhs only) in case of Post Graduate Medical degree and Rs. 25,00,000/- (Rupees twenty five lakhs only) in case of Post Graduate Medical Diploma to the Government.

(9) Any cancellation or surrender shall be done at the Directorate of Medical Education after the last date of admission for that academic year.

NOTE: The candidates are advised to strictly adhere to the above said rules. Lenience in any matter explained above will not be entertained. The Government/Department of Medical Education / KEA hold all the powers to cancel the candidature of candidates who do not comply with the rules and regulations.

Admission to PG Medical and PG Dental seats shall be made in accordance with the Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for selection and admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma courses Rules, 2006 (Amendments) as amended from time to time and therefore the details and instructions contained in this Information Bulletin are subject to the said Rules and Government orders. In case of any discrepancy, the Rules shall prevail.
