(i) A colour blind person will not be eligible for appointment. If at any stage of service career, a person is found to be colour blind, he will be medically boarded out as per SHAPE policy in vogue in the ITBPF.

(ii) The candidates must not suffer from knock knees, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in the eyes and should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of duties.

(b) Tattoos: -
