- ✓ **Application Number shall be used as Login ID and the DOB as password for the Online Test.**
- ✓ **The online test will be in English Language only.**
- ✓ **The online test will be with multiple choice objective questions.**

- Only one question will be displayed on the computer screen at a time. The candidate should click on “Next” to go to the next question or on “Previous” button provided at the bottom of the screen to go to the previous question.
- The candidate can choose to unmark his/her answer by clicking the “Clear” button provided at the bottom of the screen.
- The timer is available on the TOP RIGHT HAND CORNER of the screen; you are requested to keep a tab on it to ensure that you plan yourexam within the allocated time.
- The list of attempted and un-attempted questions is shown in the right side of the screen. You can click on any of the attempted ones to revise the answers in case you wish so.
- Candidate has the option to bookmark a question in case he/she wishes to review it at a later stage by clicking on the “Mark” button available at the bottom of the screen. The Bookmark on a particular question can be removed by clicking on “Mark”.
- Candidates should use the “Next” OR “Previous” button or click on the question number displayed at the right side of the screen to move back and forth between questions. The answers will be saved whenever the candidate goes to the next question, by clicking on “Next” OR “Previous” button. However, the last question will be saved automatically after answering.
- If a candidate finishes the paper within the stipulated time, he/she can end the test by clicking the “End Test” button. **However, candidates will not be allowed to leave the test hall till the end of the stipulated time.**


- On the completion of the test duration, even if the candidate does not click on the “End Test” button, his/her test will be automatically submitted by the computer
