### 3.4 Additional acceptable sports achievement eligibility norms for Specific disciplines only.

#### 3.4.1 Body Building:-

Sports achievements in the event conducted by Indian Body Builders Federation (IBBF) or its affiliated units after 31/12/2021 will not be considered.

However, the certificates issued by the Associations of Indian Universities and the International Federations for recognized sports achievement in the game of Body Building will be permissible.

#### 3.4.2 Table Tennis:-

In Badminton and Table Tennis, sportspersons may also be considered for recruitment on the basis of their Current Annual All India Rankings: in different levels (Grade Pay and Pay bands), as per following criteria:-

**3.4.6 Powerlifting (Men & Women) :-**

However, the certificates issued by the Associations of Indian Universities and the International Federations for recognized sports achievement in the game of Powerlifting will be considered.

**3.4.7 Handball (Men & Women) :-**

Sports achievements in the event organized by Handball Association of India on or after 25.07.2023 will be considered.

However, the certificates issued by the Associations of Indian Universities and the International Federations for recognized sports achievement in the game of Handball will be considered.

**3.4.8 Hockey (Men & Women) :-**

Hockey India may be treated as the recognized National Sports Federation for the game of Hockey.

**3.4.9 Weightlifting (Men & Women):**

In Weightlifting Sports achievements from 01/06/2025 updated new bodyweight categories will be considered.

- 4.2 After ensuring the correctness of the particulars in the application form, candidates are required to pay fees through the payment gateway which has been integrated with the online application. No change / edit option will be allowed thereafter.
- 4.3 The payment can be made by using Debit Card / Credit Card / Internet Banking/UPI etc. by providing required details information as asked on the screen. Transaction charges for online payment, if any, will be borne by the candidates.
- 4.4 On successful completion of the transaction, e-receipt with the date entered by the candidate will be generated which should be saved / printed and retained by the candidate. ## 5. **FEE EXEMPTIONS**

- a. \*Minorities mean Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists and Zoroastrians (Parsis) & Jains.
- For claiming exemption/refund of the examination fee, Minority candidates should **upload 'self-declaration'** as per **Annexure-'A'** at the time of filing up of online application. At the time of document verification, such candidates claiming exemption of examination fee will also be required to furnish 'Minority community declaration' affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper that he/she belongs to any of the above minority community. If the affidavit is not produced during Document Verification, their candidature will be rejected.
- b. \*\*Economically Backward Classes (EBC) will mean the candidates whose Family Income is less than Rs. 50,000/- Per Annum.

### **Authorities who are authorized to issue income certificate for the purpose of identifying Economically Backward Classes (EBC):-**

- (i) District Magistrate or any other Revenue Officer up to the level of Tehsildar.
- (ii) Sitting Member of Parliament of Lok Sabha for persons of their own constituency.
- (iii) BPL card or any other certificate issued by the Central Government under a recognized poverty alleviation program or Izzat MST issued by Railways.
- (iv) Union Minister may also recommend for any persons from anywhere in the country to be considered as EBC.
- (v) Sitting Members of Parliament of Rajya Sabha for persons of the district in which these MPs normally reside.

## 6. **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

All eligible candidates will be called for trial and after trial, only the FIT candidates (**securing 25 or more, out of 40 marks for Game skill, physical fitness and coach's observations during trial**) shall be assessed for next stage of recruitment. Candidates declared NOT FIT by the Trial Committee will not be assessed further by the Recruitment Committee.

**7. ONLINE APPLICATION**

7.1 Candidates are required to apply ONLINE by visiting [www.rrc-wr.com](http://www.rrc-wr.com).

7.2 Candidates are required to log on to the RRC/WR website [www.rrc-wr.com](http://www.rrc-wr.com) provided for filling ONLINE application for recruitment against sports quota and fill up the personal details/Bio-data etc carefully.

**NOTE-I:** Candidates should be in possession of Aadhaar card. At the time of registration, candidates have to fill 12 digits Aadhaar Card number.
